New Delhi, Mar 26: Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw announced five new reforms under Indian Railways' 2026 "Reform Express" on March 26, bringing the total to nine, with direct benefits for Tamil Nadu's key industries like salt production in Thoothukudi and automobile hubs in Melpakkam and Walajabad. Tamil Nadu's Salt Boost

Tamil Nadu, a top salt producer alongside Gujarat and Rajasthan (national output: 35 million tonnes/year), sees railways transport 9.2 million tonnes annually—25% industrial, 65% human consumption. New stainless steel containers with top-loading and hydraulic side-discharge tackle corrosion, seepage, and handling losses, enabling direct loading from sites like Vedaranyam (Nagapattinam) for seamless multimodal rail-truck shifts over 1,000-2,500 km routes. Automobile Gains for TN Hubs

TN's plants in Melpakkam and Walajabad (near Renault-Nissan, Hyundai, Ford) produce amid 31 million national vehicles yearly (5 million passenger), but rail share is just 24%. Reforms allow custom high-capacity wagons for route-specific needs (e.g., SOD constraints), mirroring bulk cement's rail tonnage surge from 37,000 (Sep 2025) to 95,000 (Jan 2026). Construction Overhaul

Seven changes enhance quality: 50% single-project eligibility



5 new rly reforms, major boost for TN's salt, automobile sectors

Tatkal reforms removed 3 crore fake IRCTC accounts via bots/

Prior reforms cover on-board cleaning (86 trains), cargo terminals, RailTech (94 shortlisted proposals), and e-RCT. These position TN for industrial rail growth, self-reliance, and better services.

BJP releases list of it's 27 Assembly constituencies

Chennai, Mar 26: The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has unveiled its list of 27 constituencies it will contest in Tamil Nadu as part of the AIADMK-led alliance for the 2026 Assembly elections, signalling a strategic reshuffle compared to its 2021 electoral footprint.

Notably, the party has opted out of contesting in key constituencies it had previously won. State BJP president K. Annamalai's predecessor Nainar Nagendran had secured victory in Tirunelveli (Nellai), while Vanathi Srinivasan had won from Coimbatore South in 2021. However, both these constituencies are absent from the BJP's 2026 contest list.

The party's revised strategy is also evident in its limited presence

in northern districts, where it is not contesting even a single seat in several regions. Shift from 2021 Performance

In the 2021 Assembly elections, BJP contested 20 constituencies, winning four: Tirunelveli – Nainar Nagendran Nagercoil – M.R. Gandhi Modakkurichi – C.K. Saraswathi Coimbatore South – Vanathi Srinivasan Constituencies for 2026

For the upcoming 2026 elections, BJP will contest the following 27 constituencies under the AIADMK alliance:

Mylapore, Thali, Modakkurichi, Udhagamandalam, Avinashi (SC), Tiruppur South, Coimbatore North, Gandarvakottai (SC), Pudukkottai, Tirupattur, Madurai South, Sattur, Tiruchendur, Vasudevanallur (SC),

Radhapuram, Nagercoil, Vilavancode, Avadi, Tiruvannamalai, Thanjavur, Tiruvarur, Aranthangi, Manamadurai (SC), Ramanathapuram, Kulachal, Padmanabhapuram, and Rasipuram (SC). District-Wise Presence

Out of Tamil Nadu's 38 districts, BJP is contesting in only 20 districts. Key concentrations include: Kanyakumari district – 4 constituencies Pudukkottai district – 3 constituencies Sivaganga and Tiruppur districts – 2 constituencies each Candidates Yet to Be Announced

The BJP has so far released only the list of constituencies. The names of candidates for these seats are yet to be officially announced and are expected in the coming days as alliance negotiations and internal consultations conclude.

Spanning 11,500 sq ft, the facility features a 2,500 sq ft modern showroom blending immersive brand experience with seamless customer support. Rapid Expansion Plan

Led by dealer principal Mr. Raaj Sekar, this milestone underscores VinFast's push into India's EV

market. The company targets 75 dealerships across 60+ cities by year-end, spanning metros and emerging hubs to make premium electric SUVs accessible nationwide.

CEO Mr. Tapan Ghosh stated: "We have attained a key milestone with 50 showrooms established nationwide... This rapid growth underscores VinFast's pivotal role in advancing India's electric vehicle ecosystem." Premium EVs and Ownership Perks

Flagship models VF 6 and VF 7 boast 5-star Bharat NCAP safety ratings, backed by roadside

assistance, 3 years free maintenance, and warranties up to 10 years/200,000 km. Initiatives like Value Assured (guaranteed resale value), free V-Green charging until March 31, 2029, and Vingroup's "Trade Gas for Electric" 3% discount (till March 31, 2026) ease the switch to green mobility.

VinFast is building a full EV ecosystem—manufacturing, charging, after-sales, and battery recycling—in partnership with banks, prioritizing customer confidence and sustainable transport.

DMK finalises seat sharing, eyes strong poll show

Chennai, Mar 26: The M. K. Stalin-led Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam will contest at least 165 seats in the Tamil Nadu Assembly elections after concluding seat-sharing within its Secular Progressive Alliance of 26 parties.

A total of 66 seats have been allotted to allies. The Indian National Congress received 28 seats, followed by Viduthalai Chiruthaigal Katchi (8), Communist Party of India (5), Communist Party of India (Marxist) (5), Marumalarchi Dravida Munnetra

Kazhagam (4), and Indian Union Muslim League and Humanist People's Party (2 each).

In a key move, Stalin announced that candidates from both DMK and allies will contest 175 constituencies under the party's 'Rising Sun' symbol, showcasing alliance unity.

In a letter to cadres, Stalin said the seat-sharing was finalised through extensive consultations, balancing fairness and electoral prospects. He highlighted the DMK government's "Dravidian model" achievements and credited allies

for support on social justice and secular policies.

Over 16,500 aspirants participated in candidate selection interviews, reflecting strong grassroots engagement. Stalin urged workers to back all alliance candidates, stressing unity to win across all 234 constituencies.

With seat-sharing complete, the alliance is now gearing up for an intense campaign ahead of the high-stakes polls.

Longer windows: Cancel up to 72 hours (full refund), 24 hours (no penalty), or 8 hours before train departure—extended from old 48/12/4-hour limits. No extra charges!

Cancel anywhere: Bought a counter ticket? Now refund it at any station across India, not

just the starting one.

E-tickets simplified:

Skip filing TDR forms—refunds happen automatically on cancellation.

These match new "early charting" (done 9-18 hours before departure), so you know seat status sooner and can plan alternate travel if waitlisted.

Rlys overhauls construction rules

New Delhi, Mar 26: Union Railways Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw announced seven major reforms on Tuesday to tighten construction standards in railway projects, aiming to boost quality, transparency, and on-time delivery amid India's massive infra push.

Firms must now show capability for 50% of project value via a single prior work (up from 35%), plus at least 20% experience in railway-specific tasks like signalling (most complex), overhead electrification, or tracks. This ensures only proven players bid for big jobs.

Bid security is now locked at 2% of project cost, weeding out non-serious entrants and serious tender process. Mandatory Checks and Plans: Projects over Rs 10 crore require bid capacity assessment. Every contract demands a detailed execution work plan before groundbreaking, enabling real-time monitoring. Curbing Corruption, Subcontract Abuse

Strict bans hit corrupt, fraudulent, or anti-competitive practices with heavy penalties. Subcontracting caps drop to 40% (from 70%)—contractors must directly handle 60% for true accountability.

Bids over 5% below estimate trigger an extra 5% performance guarantee, stopping "predatory" offers that spark disputes and delays later.

These steps build a robust framework for efficient infra, cutting risks in complex rail works and aligning with national goals for reliable transport networks.

Chennai gets advanced blood test for early alzheimer's detection

Chennai, Mar 26:

A major step in dementia screening has arrived in Chennai with the launch of the Mispa i60 at Neuberger Diagnostics, offering a simple blood test to detect early signs of Alzheimer's disease. The non-invasive test uses biomarkers like p-tau and amyloid proteins to identify early changes in the brain, helping doctors detect the disease even before symptoms appear. While it supports clinical diagnosis, it does not replace imaging or CSF testing. Experts say the test

can also help distinguish Alzheimer's from other forms of dementia, improving accuracy in diagnosis and treatment planning.

Initial findings from patients tested at Neuberger's OMR centre showed that 45% had biomarker patterns linked to Alzheimer's, aligning closely with traditional diagnostic methods.

The development marks a significant advancement in accessible, early-stage screening for Alzheimer's, offering faster and cost-effective diagnosis options.
