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No LPG shortage in TN, says SLC

Chennai, Apr 30: V.C. Asokan, the State Level Coordinator (SLC) for the Oil Industry in Tamil Nadu, has issued a formal statement to allay public fears regarding the supply of petroleum products and Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG). Amidst rumors of potential shortages, the industry head confirmed that the state's energy supply chain remains robust and fully operational.

The statement emphasizes that Indian Oil (IOC), Bharat Petroleum (BPC), and Hindustan Petroleum (HPC) have maintained adequate stocks of Petrol and Diesel at all retail outlets across Tamil Nadu and Puducherry.

"The entire supply chain—stretching from refineries to terminals, depots, and eventually to retail outlets—

is functioning seamlessly," the statement read. Authorities are continuously monitoring stock levels at every location to ensure that fuel availability remains uninterrupted. The public is strongly advised to maintain normal purchasing habits and avoid panic buying, which can create artificial localized shortages.

Addressing concerns over cooking gas, the Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) reported that domestic LPG supplies are being maintained without disruption. Key highlights include:

Reduced Waiting Period: Thanks to sustained efforts and government monitoring, the delivery time for LPG cylinders has been brought down to less than 5 days in most areas.

Backlog Management: Specific

pockets with higher backlogs are being monitored at a central level, with immediate interventions planned to further slash delivery timelines.

Auto LPG: Sufficient stocks of Auto LPG are also available across the OMC network, with an enhanced focus on meeting consumer demand efficiently.

The Oil Industry's reassurance comes as a relief to consumers and transporters alike. Mr. Asokan reiterated that the OMCs remain committed to providing reliable and uninterrupted energy access to all citizens. The public is requested to remain calm and continue with their regular consumption patterns, as there is currently no cause for concern regarding energy security in the state.



11th National Football, Kanchipuram Golden Era team leaves to Chhattisgarh

Kanchipuram, Apr 30: Young players belonging to the Kanchipuram 'Golden Era' Football Club departed yesterday to participate in the 11th National Football Tournament, which is scheduled to be held in the state of Chhattisgarh.

May 1 declared dry day across TN

Chennai, Apr 30: The Government of Tamil Nadu has declared May 1, 2026 (Friday), a mandatory dry day across the state in view of May Day (Labour Day). All liquor sales will remain suspended for the day as part of statutory observance of the workers' festival.

According to official sources, all Tamil Nadu State Marketing Corporation (TASMAR) retail outlets and their attached bars in Chennai and across Tamil Nadu

will remain closed. No legal sale of alcohol will be permitted during the day.

The prohibition also extends to FL2 licensed bars in clubs and FL3/FL3(A) bars operating in hotels, ensuring a complete halt to liquor sales statewide.

May 1 is observed as International Workers' Day, marking the historic struggle of labourers for fair working conditions and rights. As a statutory holiday, it is traditionally enforced as a dry day in Tamil

Nadu.

Similar restrictions will be in place in several other parts of the country. States such as Maharashtra will observe a dry day for Labour Day, while closures are also expected in Delhi due to the observance of Buddha Purnima.

Authorities have urged the public and licensed establishments to strictly adhere to the regulations, warning that violations will invite legal action.

INTUC TN President extends May Day greetings

Chennai, Apr 30: Tamil Nadu INTUC President M. Panneerselvam on Thursday extended his May Day greetings to workers and emphasised the need for unity to safeguard labour rights.

In his message, he recalled the historic struggle of workers in Chicago, where labourers fought and sacrificed their lives to secure the eight-hour workday. He noted that May 1 is observed worldwide to commemorate this milestone in the history of labour movements. Criticising the policies of

the Bharatiya Janata Party-led Union government, Panneerselvam alleged that public sector undertakings are being handed over to large corporates and that labour laws detrimental to workers are being introduced.

He called upon all trade unions to rise above political differences and stand united to protect workers' rights and resist exploitation. "On this May Day, let us pledge to work together to secure justice and safety for all workers," he said.

Highlighting the dignity of labour, he added that workers are the backbone

of society and expressed hope that prosperity and well-being reach every working individual. He concluded by conveying his warm wishes to all workers on the occasion of May Day.

CWMA reviews Cauvery water position; TN flags allocation concerns
New Delhi, April 30: The 50th meeting of the Cauvery Water Management Authority (CWMA) was convened in New Delhi on Tuesday, where key issues relating to water storage, inter-state sharing, and compliance with tribunal and court directives came under discussion. The meeting, chaired by S.K. Haldar, saw participation from basin states, with Tamil Nadu officials joining via video conference from Chennai. The state was represented by J. Jayakanthan, Member Secretary of the Water Resources Department, and R. Subramanian, Karnataka's Additional Chief Secretary. Secretary was absent, with a representative attending instead. During the deliberations, Tamil Nadu informed the Authority that the storage level at the Mettur Dam stood at 42.397 TMC as of April 28, 2026. The state also reported that 1,503 cusecs of water is currently being released from the reservoir to meet drinking water needs, industrial demand,
